Sellers will be able to profit from flexible and reliable shipping options to offer their customers the service that best suits their needs, whether that's overnight or ground, and the possibility to ship six days a week including Saturdays (coverage where available), eBay explained.

Domestic UPS shipping options on eBay will include UPS Ground, UPS 2nd Day Air, UPS Next Day Air Saver, and UPS Next Day Air which will be available to all sellers later this month.
