

Slovenian Post agrees â‚¬105m takeover of logistics firm Intereuropa

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Slovenian Post will expand its logistics activities dramatically with the acquisition of leading Slovenian freight company Intereuropa for a reported â‚¬105 million. Once its biggest-ever acquisition is completed, the state-owned postal company is poised to generate well over a third of its revenues from parcel and logistics activities in future. In 2018, the postal operator had revenues of about â‚¬250 million while Intereuropa generated turnover of about â‚¬160 million. PoÅ¡ta Slovenije announced on Friday that it had signed a contract with a consortium of several banks to buy a 72% stake in Intereuropa. The price was not disclosed but local media put the price at â‚¬105 million. The postal company's bid was apparently preferred to that of British logistics company Xpediator, which said last month that it was pulling out of the sale process.
