

DHL to provide in-plant logistics for Jaguar Land Rover's new factory in Brazil

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"We're delighted to have secured this new contract with Jaguar Land Rover which builds on our long-standing relationship," said DHL Supply Chain's Director of Business Development for Brazil, Miquele Lioi. "Our proposal was built on three key pillars: unrivalled sector expertise, derived from managing more than 250 automotive

Goods arriving at the warehouse will be stored in 8,500 pallet locations where DHL will sort, move and sequence parts, as well as sub-assemble kits of up to 25 components, before shipping in sequence to the assembly line.
