Located at Shop 8, 15 Christopher Lane, the new Tarneit Parcels offers streamlined, parcels-focused services that blend in-person assistance with convenient self-service options. Customers can send, collect and return parcels more easily, with added flexibility through 24/7 access to secure Parcel Lockers and vending machines stocked with packaging, stamps and other mailing essentials.

Australia Post General Manager, Retail Operations South, Kate Foley, said demand for online shopping continues to increase, driving the need for the new Post Office formats that better support growing communities.

"As Tarneit and surrounding suburbs continue to grow, this new Parcels Post Office is designed to keep pace with demand by providing locals with greater access to postal services, including the convenience of 24/7 self-service with our Parcel Lockers and vending machines.
