



# International Post Corporation appoints new Chief Information Officer

A Belgian national, Peter Billiau graduated as Civil Engineer from the Catholic University of Louvain. He is also a licensed Human Element Practitioner (LHEPTM).

my experience to support IPC in the transformation already underway, drawing on the most recent technological advances, including AI. I am pleased to have the opportunity to contribute to the growth of a sector that is fundamental to both the economy and society.”

Since he joined IPC in 2019, Markus has been successfully leading the IPC IT team to elevate IPC's IT capabilities, to better serve the members, and played a pivotal role in enabling IPC to achieve the ISO Certification.
