DHL collaborates with The Range Imports Team to manage 15,000 TEU of ocean freight by providing Vendor Management in country of origin, proactive alerting of shipping exceptions and global coordination via Control Towers in Hong Kong and the UK. The Range also benefits from enhanced reporting, including detailed key performance indicators and management information, which underpins a supply chain development programme.
